To Whom It May Concern:

I am the Special Events coordinator for Millennium Place in which is located about 5 minutes east of the Edmonton city limits. Millennium Place hosts large banquets in a 35,000 square foot special events facility. The Sawmill Restaurant Group has catered two major functions here in the past two years. In June of 2003 they catered the Celanese 50th anniversary dinner which was a buffet style dinner for 965 people. In June of 2004 they catered the Fort Saskatchewan High School Graduation dinner which was a buffet style dinner for 1100 people.

The service and food quality was first class for both events. Sawmill showed the ability to work within the unique features of our facility which includes no on-site cooking facilities. Despite these challenges the food was outstanding. I received several positive comments from our guests about both the taste and presentation of the meal.

Beyond the outstanding quality of the food I was extremely impressed by the service and professionalism shown by Sawmill. They were tremendously easy to work with and took a leadership role in the event by coordinating the order the tables were called to the buffet tables. They were able to serve the 1100 person graduation event in less than 25 minutes.

Sawmill's staff is also an enormous asset to their operations because they are able to utilize staff from their restaurants, which means they are fully trained and experienced to work major banquet functions. Their staff was outstanding and had constant supervision and guidance to coordinate and assist them.
